## April 13 and Beyond

- These activities/assignments will be for report card marks.
- Student's marks will be locked in as a baseline as of March 12. No student will receive a lower mark than what they had March 12. Students marks will only go up.

- Lines of communication need to go both ways. Teachers will communicate with families. It is important for families to acknowledge the teacher's communication efforts.
